

How to get to Münster?

By train:

Münster is easy to reach by train via high speed Intercity Express trains. Choose Münster "Hauptbahnhof" (central station) as your destination.

When you have arrived in Münster, how do you find the Institute of Hygiene?

By bus: The Institute of Hygiene is situated in the Robert Koch street 41. Busses leave every 10 min at the central station from track B1 and C2. Busstops are „Hüfferstiftung“, „Jungeblodtplatz“ and „Domagkstraße“. The bus will take up to 12 min.

By car:

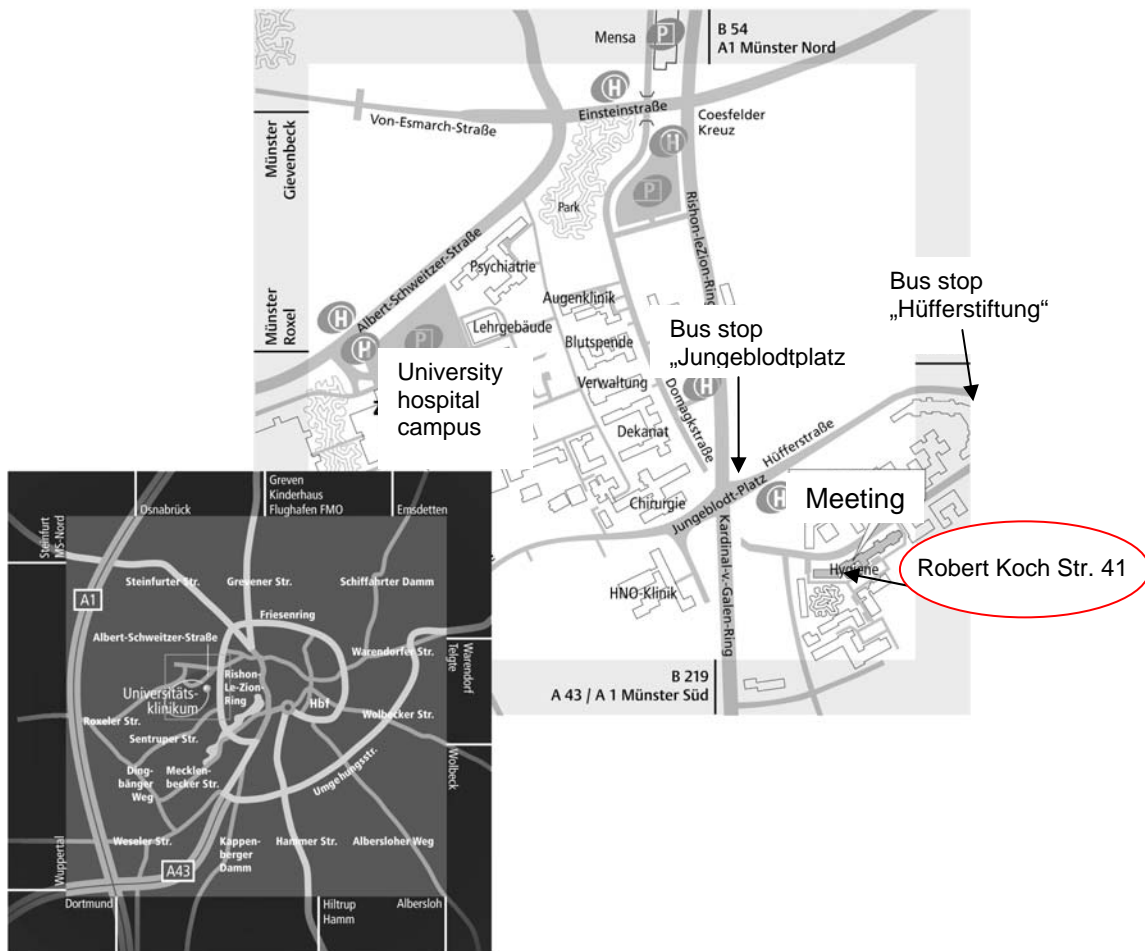
Münster is situated in the North West of Germany. It is reached through the A1 Autobahn.

When you have arrived in Münster, how do you find the Institute of Hygiene?

From the North: Leave the A1 (direction Bremen to Münster) at Exit Münster-Nord and just follow the road into town. Having entered Münster (a yellow sign indicates the entry into the town), turn right at the second set of traffic lights. Follow the road for four sets of traffic lights and turn left into Pottkamp. After 150 meters turn again left, after 250 meters you reach the Robert Koch street. On your right hand you find the Institute of Hygiene.

From the South: Leave the A 1 (direction Köln to Münster) at Exit Münster-Süd, or, if you are on the A 43, just continue to the end of the A 43 (direction Wuppertal to Münster). Simply follow the road, continue for Münster Centrum for about 6 kilometers until you notice a lake on your left; turn left at this set of traffic lights and follow the road until you reach a T- junction; turn left again. You are in Hüfferstr. and will find at the next crossing a hospital-like building. Turn left and after 100 meters turn again right into Robert Koch Str. At the end of this street on the left you find the Institute of Hygiene.
